<p>Entry Process</p>	<p>There are two methods of entry for this year's event. The original paper entry process and a new online entry system. The online entry system will be a more secure process and will allow for confirmation to be obtained within moments of your entry being processed.</p> <p>The online system will ensure that your entry is processed correctly and that your payment is taken via a secure site.</p> <p>When entering online you MUST provide a school/institution email address. For your entry to be accepted into the event we will require confirmation from your school/institution that you do attend their institution and confirmation of your school year. This will be completed via email.</p> <p>We would recommend that you complete the application online to ensure all of your details are correct.</p> <p>By using the online booking system it will eliminate the chance of your entry getting lost in the post, processing errors of your details and allow a secure payment to be made.</p> <p>The online entry system can be accessed via www.britishschoolsjudo.org.</p> <p>Unfortunately we cannot accept card payments from American Express and Visa Electron cards.</p> <p>Closing date for entries is strictly Wednesday 10th March 2010 OR when 300 entries have been received.</p>
<p>Participation: (Eligibility, Categories, Minimum grades and Age)</p>	<p>Event Eligibility</p> <p>This is a level 3, Development event and is not open to any players who are members of the England Squad programme or who have won a medal at the BJA National Age Banded Championships/ British Championships in the last three years. Talent ID Staff from the Home Country programme's will be at the Championships and medallists may be invited to attend the England Squad Area Training Sessions. Coaches from Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland are asked to respect this qualification and not enter over qualified players.</p> <p>This event is open to all school children who comply with the criteria above. However, if the player is a member of an association other than the BJA, Judo Scotland, NIJF, WJA, AJA or BJC, players must send a copy of their association's insurance policy to the BJA, Suite B, Loughborough Technology Centre, Epinal Way, Loughborough LE11 3GE. No entry can be accepted from such players without proof of insurance.</p> <p>Players from Associations that do not have or cannot produce proof of insurance will be given the option of buying BJA temporary cover on the day, however the player/s entry into the event MUST have been received before the closing date for entries (Wednesday 10th March 2010).</p> <p>If you are unsure that your insurance will be accepted at this event please contact James Sills on 01509 631695.</p> <p>Categories and minimum grades and ages Academic years 7, 8 and 9: Recommended minimum grade – green belt</p>

	<p>Academic years 10 and 11: Recommended minimum grade – green belt</p> <p>Academic years 12 and 13: Recommended minimum grade – blue belt</p> <p>All coaches will be responsible for ensuring that their athletes are ready for this level of competition.</p> <p>All players MUST bring their valid BJA/BJC/AJA or affiliate judo licence to the event.</p>
Competition Format:	<p>Compound Knock Out will be used in categories where there are more than 8 players. In categories where there are 8 players or less, pools and knock out will be used.</p> <p>The Tournament Director reserves the right to amalgamate categories where there are insufficient entries.</p> <p>Please note: Depending on the number of entries a different competition format may be used.</p> <p>Contest Times Academic years 7, 8 and 9: Three minutes Academic years: 10 and 11: Four minutes Academic years 12 and 13: Four minutes</p> <p>Two minutes <i>Golden Score</i> in all categories .</p> <p>Medals will be given out at the end of each category. Medals will only be given to players wearing competition-acceptable white judogi.</p> <p>Players called up first may wear a blue judogi if they wish. However, players with blue judogi MUST also have a white judogi.</p>

Seeding:	There will be no seeding for this event.
Weight Categories:	<p>Academic years 7, 8 and 9: Armlocks and strangles are NOT permitted Male: u30kg, u34kg, u38kg, u42kg, u46kg, u50kg, u55kg, u60kg, u66kg, u73kg and over 73kg. Female: u32kg, U36kg, u40kg, u44kg, u48kg, u52kg, u57kg, u63kg u70kg and over 70kg.</p> <p>Academic years: 10 and 11: Strangles ONLY are permitted Male: u34kg, u38kg, u42kg, u46kg, u50kg, u55kg, u60kg, u66kg, u73kg, U81kg and over 81kg Female: u36kg, u40kg, u44kg, u48kg, u52kg, u57kg, u63kg u70kg, under 78kg and over 78kg</p> <p>Academic years 12 and 13: Armlocks and Strangles are permitted Male: u55kg, u60kg, u66kg, u73kg, u81kg, u90kg, u100kg and over 100kg Female: u44kg, u48kg, u52kg, u57kg, u63kg u70kg, under 78kg and over 78kg.</p> <p>Please note: There is no need to double enter, players will fight in the weight group they make on the day of the event.</p>

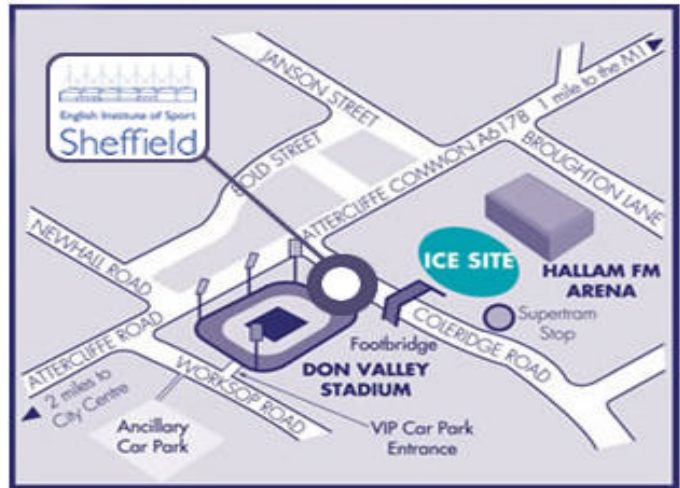
<p>Registration & Weigh In</p>	<p>Registration & weigh-in will take place on Saturday 20th March 2010 at the EIS Sheffield at the following times:</p> <p>Years 10 and 11: 09.00am – 9.45am Years 7, 8 and 9: 10.15am – 10.45am Years 12 and 13: 11.15am – 11.45am</p> <p>All competitors must bring their valid BJA or affiliate judo licence to registration.</p> <p>As a high number of the competitors are going to be under 18 an open weigh in will take place at this event, therefore all players entering this event regardless of age will be weighed in under U18 rules.</p> <p>Please note that due to this ALL competitors will receive the weight allowance and therefore ALL competitors MUST weigh in wearing competition acceptable judogi trousers for boys (0.5kg) or competition acceptable judogi trousers and t-shirt for girls (0.6kg).</p> <p>Players are NOT permitted to change in the designated official weigh-in area.</p> <p>Sweating off: If a player is seen by BJA staff or officials sweating off, they will be asked to go straight to the scales and weigh in. A toilet visit will be allowed but no more running. If the athlete refuses to go to the scales they will be withdrawn from the competition.</p>

<p>Spectator Tickets:</p>	<p>Adult Day Ticket: £6 / Concession (under 16's and OAP's) Day Ticket: £3 Tickets can be purchased on the day only at EIS, Sheffield from the BJA ticket desk.</p>
<p>Photography:</p>	<p>We intend to have various accredited photographers at this event and we are planning to have some form of filming and internet broadcast of some mats (connections permitting). Whilst no child's name will be published alongside their image and all of those conducting the filming and or photography will have undergone the necessary checks the BJA's Lead Child Protection officer, Julie Moores, needs to know as soon as possible of any players entered who for legal or child protection reasons cannot have their image published in the public domain.</p> <p>You should note that if no notification is received the BJA will be using images taken at this event for media and publicity purposes in order to promote the positive aspect of our sport.</p> <p>Spectators wishing to use photographic equipment must register as they enter the hall.</p>
<p>Coaching Passes:</p>	<p>Coaches MUST produce a VALID BJA Coach Award card in person in order to be eligible for the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To gain entry to BJA centrally administered National Events (ALL Coaches, whether coaching or not on the day, will be eligible for a 50% reduction on the spectator fee on production of their Coach Award card at this event). • To gain mat side access with their player at a BJA centrally administered National Event (Only one coach per player will be permitted at any one time).

Directions:	<p>Directions to EIS Sheffield:</p> <p>From M1 (travelling North): Leave motorway at junction 34 (Sheffield Meadowhall). At the roundabout follow signs A6178 City Centre and Attercliffe. Go past Meadowhall Shopping Centre on your right. Keep straight on this road. Go past the Sheffield Arena on your left. Keep straight on this road (Attercliffe Road). EIS Sheffield is on Coleridge road by the traffic lights (by Natwest Bank)</p> <p>From M1 (travelling South): - Leave motorway at Junction 34. Follow brown signs for Don Valley Stadium / HallamFM Arena (A6109 also signed City). Pass Meadowhall shopping centre on your left, travelling straight on for approximately two miles. At the first roundabout turn left on to Hawke Street / Janson Street (following signs for Don Valley Stadium / Hallam FM Arena). At next roundabout turn right on to Attercliffe Common (A6178), signed iceSheffield. At second set of traffic lights (opposite Natwest bank) turn left onto Coleridge Road. Take next right into car park.</p> <p>From City Centre: Follow signs for M1 / M18 until reaching Park Square Roundabout. From roundabout use lane signed A57. See brown signs for Lower Don Valley (A6109). After exiting roundabout on to A57 "Sheffield Parkway" take left lane at first set of traffic lights signed "Lower Don Valley (A6109)". At second set of lights turn right onto Wicker. At stone arches bare right on to Savile Street A6109. Carry straight on for 2 miles following signs for "Don Valley Stadium / Hallam FM Arena". At first roundabout turn right signed (Hallam FM Arena / Don Valley Stadium) on to A6102 Hawke Street / Janson Street. At next roundabout turn right on to Attercliffe Road A6178. Take second left (opposite Natwest bank) onto Coleridge Road. Take first right into EIS Sheffield.</p> <p>Supertram: Catch the yellow route tram from Sheffield City Centre or Meadowhall Shopping Centre. Get off the tram at the Don Valley Stadium / Arena tram stop. EIS Sheffield is just two minutes walk from the tram stop.</p>
